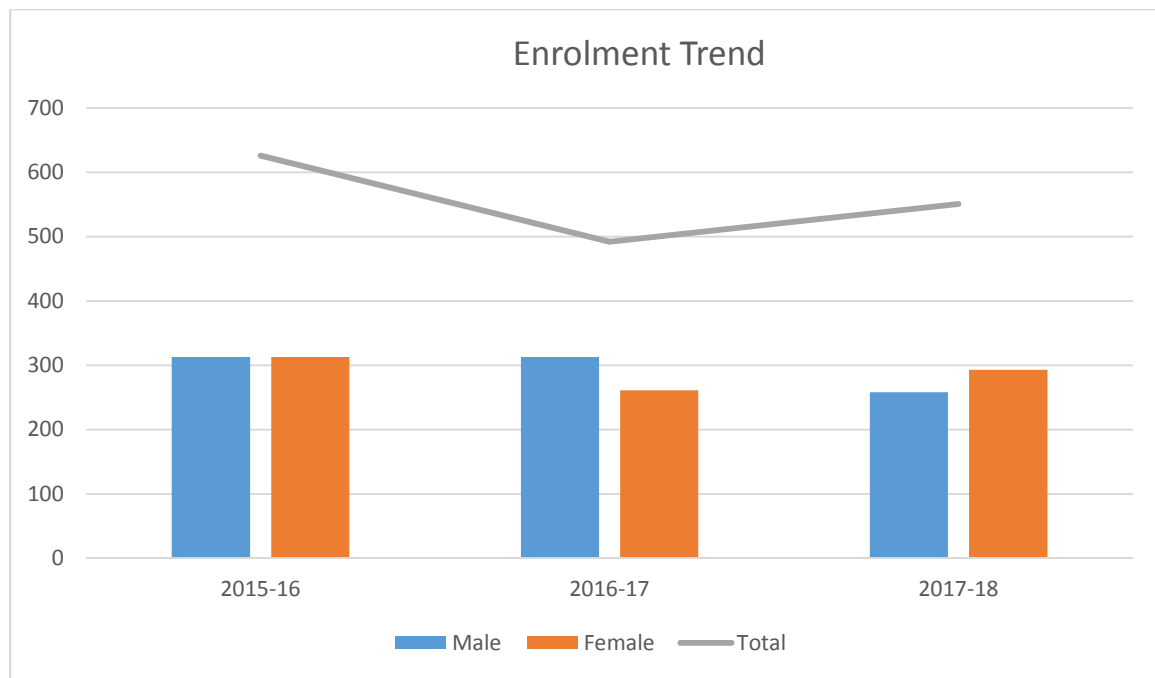

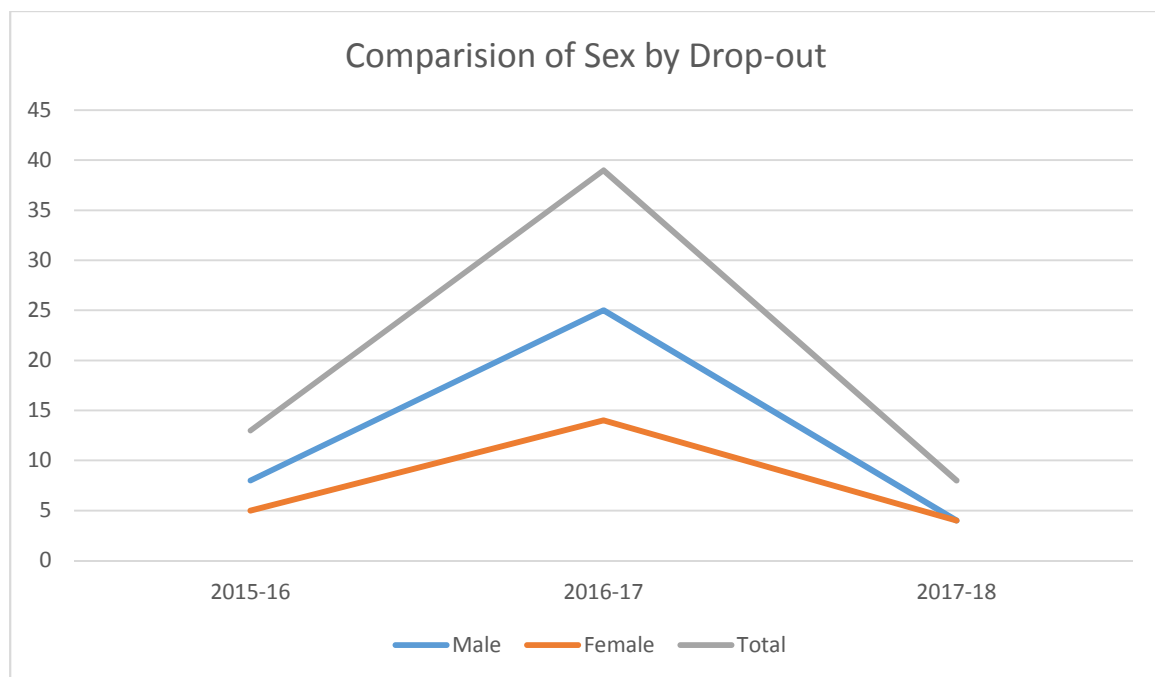

Chronological Activities/Events (News in brief)

12th July, 2017:

A two-day induction programme was organized for the newly enrolled students of the college. The programme was conducted in two halls separately for Arts and Science streams. Senior faculty members took part in the presentations of different areas of the institution and the curriculum making the students aware of the things and situations they are going to meet and follow in their venture to fully achieve their learning mission. More than two-third of enrolled students were present and benefitted.

8th August, 2017:

Teaching and ministerial staff along with members of the students' union observed the college Foundation Day by offering ritual light, fragrant smoke, fruits and sweet. All present also offered floral tribute to the statue of late founder Nongthombam Ibomcha Singh.

25th Sept., 2017:

In order to enhance students' performance through encouragement and recognition, and in compliance with the Ordinances, a committee named Oriental College Award Committee was constituted with the following persons with effect from this date for a term of three years.

7th October, 2017:

A team of Directorate of University and Higher Education, government of Manipur visited the college with a schedule format bearing INSPECTION NOTE on it as caption wherein attendance of teachers, classes conducted subject-wise & semester-wise, number of students enrolled semester-wise & stream-wise, p.c. of students' attendance, lack of teachers if any, and lack of infrastructure if any which are to be responded by each department of the college. The Principal and the teachers extended full cooperation and provided all the required information.

26th January, 2018:

50 students of the college participated the March Past Parade as Girls' Team Contingent organised by the state government to celebrate the country's 69th Republic Day 2018.

17th February, 2018:

An extension lecture programme was organised by Department of Manipuri on the topic- 'Architectural Feature of Meitei/Meetei Houses (*Meitei Yumsarol*)' with Shri N. Indramani Singh, retired Archivist and the present Member of Kangla Fort Board, Manipur, as resource person. Dr. Th. Biren Singh, Principal presided and opened the programme. Dr. M.T. Achou of Manipuri Dept. gave welcome address and introduced the invited resource person to the audience. The 20 teachers and 37 students, mostly belonging to the Department were present in the lecture and the interaction programme.

18th February, 2018:

A college cultural troop participated the 5th North East Graduate Congress-2018 organised jointly by the University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya and the Regional Institute of Science and Technology, 9th Miles during February 16-18. The team of seventeen comprising dancers, instrumentalists and others participated in Group Dance Competition performing Manipuri Folk Dance. The troop was awarded participation certificate for presenting, maintaining discipline and actively taking part in different activities during the Congress.

17th March, 2018

A part of the old Science Block occupied by Physics and Zoology Departments was demolished for new construction on the same spot. Two medium and two large rooms was at the cost of Rs.74 lakh funded under RUSA 1.0 scheme of the central government.

27th March, 2018

- A one day Outreach & Awareness Programme on Biotechnology was organised by Advanced Level Institutional Biotech Hub of G.P. Women College in collaboration with Institutional Biotech Hub of Oriental College. The function was inaugurated by the Dr. Th. Biren Singh, Principal of the college. The programme benefitted more than 56 students. 11 teachers participated the programme.
- An Extension Lecture was organised jointly by Botany and Zoology Departments on the topic- Tissue Culture and Vermicompost with Dr. Y. Sunitibala Devi, Associate Prof., G.P. Women College, Imphal as resource person. 11 teachers and 56 students were present and benefitted.

27th March, 2018:

A 4-Day Training and Workshop on Biotechnological Instrumentation & Basics of Nano-Technological Techniques was organised by the Institutional Biotech Hub of the college under sponsorship of the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, New Delhi with the objective of imparting biotechnological knowledge to students of Science, particularly Botany, Chemistry and Zoology. Altogether 98 students were present and benefitted.

20th April, 2018:

The college pleaded the Director of University & Higher Education, Govt. of Manipur for granting to open Computer Science/BCA as a subject of under-graduate programme in the college considering the emerging demand of computer skills in the job market, both in public and private sector. There is ample prospect among the local youths for getting them imparted through opening of the course in the college with less financial burden on the locals. But the letter is yet to move to the higher authority of the Govt.

28th April, 2018:

The OCSU organised annual students meet named Annual Spring Meet 2018. Various items of games & sports, social and cultural items were performed by the students.

21st May, 2018:

In order to familiarise the newly appointed teachers with the functioning of the Autonomous system and procedures followed in the college, the IQAC organised a One Day Orientation/Induction Programme on the topic of teaching-learning and evaluation systems. The opening session was presided over by Dr. S. Ranjit Singh, Principal, and graced by Prof. S. Gunadhor Singh (Former Principal of Kanan Devi College of Teachers Education and presently Guest Faculty, DMCTE) as chief guest. Three resource persons, namely Prof. S. Gunadhor Singh, L. Mani Singh (Coordinator & Controller of Examinations) and Kh. Debendra Meetei (Dean of Science) of the college delivered lectures and shared interaction on different aspects of the topic. In the programme, all 12 new incumbents were benefitted.

24th May, 2018:

The Oriental College Volleyball team participated in the Intercollege Volleyball Tournament, 2018 organised by the Manipur University, Imphal.

29th May, 2018:

4th meeting of Academic Council was held at the Conference Hall presided over by the Principal of the college

5th June, 2018:

A Tree-plantation Programme organised in connection with the World Environment Day jointly by teaching staff, OCSU and Alumni Association of the college. 100 Tree saplings were planted in and around the college campus. 42 teachers, 37 students and 10 members of Alumni were participated.

11th June, 2018:

Curriculum and Syllabus for B.A and B.Sc. Honours courses developed by the different BoS from 2016 and approved, at different times, by the A.C. and the G.B. of the college. It was released on this day by the Principal Dr. S. Ranjit Singh along with Shri I. Mani Singh (Coordinator of IQAC), Kh. Debendra Meetei (Dean of Science), Dr. Kh. Aruna Devi (Dean of Arts), H. Ibomcha Singh (Controller of Exams.), P. Mangi Devi (HOD, Botany) and L. Renuka Devi (HOD, Geography).

19th June, 2018:

A special NSS camp was organised jointly by the college NSS Unit I & II from 19 to 28 June on the theme- Youth for Nation. The main activities performed were i. conducting village level rally, ii. awareness campaigns (cleanliness and waste management), iii. House to house waste collection drives, iv. Street & drainage and Panchayat Ghar of Khamnam Leirak (Lamjaotongba GP, Imphal West) and social service at college. Besides, lectures on social issues and interest were given by different teacher-experts of the college and external resource persons. Altogether 70 students and 7 teachers participated during the camp.

21st June, 2018:

International Yoga Day was observed in the college Conference Hall by the students and the teachers. The function was presided by Dr. S. Ranjit Singh, Principal of the college. Four external resource persons- Dr. K. Shitaljit Singh (Coordinator of NSS, M.U.), Dr. S. Opendra Singh (Programme Officer of NSS I, M.U.), Dr. L. Santosh Singh (P.O. of NSSII, M.U.) and Dr. M. Nodiyachand Singh (Yoga Instructor, M.U.) adorned the function as Chief Guest and Guests of Honour. Later on Dr. Nodiachand gave a lecture on Yoga and its importance. 61 students and 12 teachers participated in the programme.
